Sir/Madam,

With reference to the subject mentioned above, I am directed to inform you that in pursuance of the provision of National commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020, the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 (48 of 1970) has been repealed with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021. With effect from the said date, the Central Council of Indian Medicine constituted under sub-division (1) of section 3 of the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 (48 of 1970) shall stand dissolved. Now, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (3) of the section 1 of the said Act, the Central Government hereby notifies that all the provisions of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020 has been come into force with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021.

- 1. This is with reference to your first appeal filed by the Director, Ayurved Services, Government of Uttar Pradesh vide ref.no: 1174/22-23 dated: 15.09.2023 to the Commission for reconsidering the reduction in number of PG seats in conditional permission issued to Government Ayurvedic College & Hospital, Chaukaghat, Varanasi- 221002, Uttar Pradesh (Inst. ID AYU0258) with 24 seats (30 seats including EWS) [instead of 30 seats (38 seats including EWS)] in 06 PG Courses namely (i) Ayurved Samhita & Siddhant-04 seats (05 seats including EWS)[instead of 05 seats(06 seats including EWS)], (ii) Rog Nidan avum Vikriti Vigyan- 03 seats (04 seats including EWS) [instead of 05 seats(06 seats including EWS)], (iii) Shalya Tantra-03 seats (04 seats including EWS) [instead of 05 seats(07 seats including EWS)], (iv) Rasa Shastra & Bhaisaijya Kalpana-05 Seats (06 seats including EWS), (v) Panchkarma -04 seats (05 seats including EWS) [instead of 05 seats(06 seats including EWS)], in PG due to non fulfillment of the basic eligibility criteria in terms of Regulation 3 of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (The Indian Medicine Central Council (Post Graduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations, 2016" and provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder and other shortcoming as mentioned in the permission vide letter of even number dated 14.08.2023.
- 2. Thereafter the said appeal was placed before the Chairman, NCISM and the Chairman NCISM constituted a Hearing Committee to provide an opportunity of hearing to the aforementioned college. Accordingly, the letter was sent to the Director, Ayurved Services, Government of Uttar Pradesh vide Commission's letter dated 29.09.2023 to appear before the designated hearing committee as constituted by the Chairman, NCISM on 03.10.2023 in respect of appeal to consider Government Ayurvedic College & Hospital, Chaukaghat, Varanasi- 221002, Uttar Pradesh (Inst. ID AYU0258) for 30 seats (38 seats including EWS)] in 06 PG Courses, filed under section 10(1)(g) and section 24(3) of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine ACT, 2020 and to produce all relevant valid documents/records/ proof to substantiate the claims and make written submission and submit an authenticated copy of evidence/verifications to commission with shortcoming wise clarifications mentioned in the seat reduction permission letter dated 14.08.2023 passed by the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM. The proceedings of appeal were held virtually on 03.10.2023 at 11.30 AM and on behalf of the college, Dr. Vinod Kumar Singh, Principal and Dr Ritu Raj Tripathi, Department of Rasashastra and Bhashajya Kalpana attended the hearing.
- 3. The hearing committee sought clarification from the, **Dr. Sashi Singh**, **Principal**, **of Government Ayurvedic College & Hospital**, **Chaukaghat**, **Varanasi- 221002**, **Uttar Pradesh (Inst. ID AYU0258)** regarding the conditional permission with seat reduction in PG Courses issued by Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM, vide letter of even number dated 14.08.2023 which is as under:-

- 4. The submissions made by Dr. Vinod Kumar Singh, Principal and Dr Ritu Raj Tripathi, Department of Rasashastra and Bhashajya Kalpana, Government Ayurvedic College & Hospital, Chaukaghat, Varanasi- 221002, Uttar Pradesh (Inst. ID AYU0258) and observations of the hearing committee was placed before the Chairman, NCISM and it has been decided by the Chairman NCISM to partially consider the appeal of the Director, Ayurved Services, Government of Uttar Pradesh dated 15.09.2023 by increasing 1 PG seat each in the department of Rog Nidan and Shalya Tantra PG courses in the conditional permission issued to Government Ayurvedic College & Hospital, Chaukaghat, Varanasi-221002, Uttar Pradesh (Inst. ID AYU0258) under section 28 of the NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2023-24.
- 5. Hence, it has been decided by the President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM to issue conditional permission to Government Ayurvedic College & Hospital, Chaukaghat, Varanasi- 221002, Uttar Pradesh (Inst. ID AYU0258) with 60 seats (75 seats including EWS) in UG (BAMS) course and 26 seats (32 seats including EWS) [instead of 30 seats (38 seats including EWS)] in 06 PG Courses namely (i) Ayurved Samhita & Siddhant-04 seats (05 seats including EWS)[instead of 05 seats (06 seats including EWS)], (ii) Rog Nidan avum Vikriti Vigyan- 04 seats (05 seats including EWS) [instead of 05 seats (06 seats including EWS)], (iii) Shalya Tantra-04 seats (05 seats including EWS) [instead of 05 seats (07 seats including EWS)], (iv) Rasa Shastra & Bhaisaijya Kalpana-05 Seats (06 seats including EWS), (v) Panchkarma -04 seats (05 seats including EWS)], and (vi) Prasuti & Stri Roga-05 seats (06 seats including EWS) [instead of 05 seats (06 seats including EWS)], under section 28 of the NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2023-24 and relevant regulations thereunder and in compliance of the direction received in the letter no. NCISM/Comm./OPT Appeal/(2023-24)-(U.P) dated 20.10.2023 by the Chairman, National Commission for Indian System of Medicine, subject to following condition:
 - i. It is further informed that minimum 15% of undergraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity with 60 seats (75 seats including EWS) and minimum 15% of postgraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity with 26 seats (32 seats including EWS) shall be treated as All India Quota. The counseling for seats under All India Quota shall be conducted by respective counseling authority as designated by Central Government for A.Y. 2023-24 and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned counseling authority of that State/UT. The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply

with the aforesaid direction of the Central Government/NCISM for All India Quota or the students admitted thereunder.

- Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under NCISM Act & 6 Regulations thereunder.
- Further, as per Sub-section (7) of Section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020, The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for 7 Indian System of Medicine may conduct evaluation and assessment of any University or medical institution at any time, either directly or through any other expert, having integrity and experience in medical profession, without any prior notice and assess and evaluate the performance, standards and benchmarks of such University or medical institution and if the college is found to be not maintaining the Minimum Essential standards as specified in the concerned Acts & Regulations then in accordance of Section 28 (1) (f) of NCISM Act, 2020 the issued permission of the college shall deemed to be withdrawn and denial of permission shall be issued by MARBISM for stoppage of admission for that particular academic year or the subsequent year.
- Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System 8 of Medicine, NCISM.
- The following requirements should be fulfilled by the college by 31st December, 2023 and send a compliance report to 9 get permission for the session 2024-25:
 - All the requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in (i) Regulation 3 of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016;
 - (ii) All the requirements of the Indian Medicine Central Council (Minimum Standards of Education in Indian Medicine) Amendment Regulations, 2016 (for Ayurveda);
 - (iii) All the requirements under the provisions of the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled in toto; and
 - (iv) All the requirements of the Indian Medicine Central Council (Post Graduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations, 2016.
- 10. The fulfillment of the conditions given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted by the college to President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine will verify that the conditions have been fulfilled for considering the permission for the academic session 2024-25.

11. Further, the letter issued vide letter of even no. dated 14.08.2023 stands withdrawn.
